SMITH'S DOCK

IAN MACDONALD

The Smith's Dock work arose with the announcement of the closure of the yard by British Shipbuilders in May 1986. Ian Macdonald and Len Tabner were already working together on a book about the river Tees estuary, which was eventually published in 1989. Smith's Dock was a major part of life on the industrial river and would have been part of a larger picture of the river scape.

Closure fast forwarded this process and with a commission from British Shipbuilders and funding help from N.A. work began in August 1986 and continued up to the last days and beyond in November 1987.

UNSETTLED

ISABELLE PATEER

"Unsettled" focuses in a metaphoric way on the idea of "progress" in a case where living environment, nature and heritage have to disappear because of industrial purposes.

The project illustrates this international tendency by focusing on a local Belgian example found in the vast expansions of the port of Antwerp and related nature compensation plans, required by the European Union which installs an artificial contrast between nature and culture.

"Unsettled" illustrates this actual case in an indirect way, exceeding a pure documentary approach.

It shows portraits of young inhabitants alternated by landscapes which bare witness to the transformed state of the area. Leaving a sourish taste by contrasting the young with the local changes, they symbolise the international tendency of global political and economic shifts and the way they manifest themselves to the people and their surroundings.

PETER DENCH

"Pickled. Soused.
Mullered. Blotto. Hog-
whimpering. Pie-eyed.
Tired and emotional;
downwind of a few.

The presence of so many words and phrases in the English language to describe a state of inebriation surely says something about the English themselves: this is a nation that seeks the comfort of oblivion – towards the bottom of a bottle.

But why do the English tipple until they fall over? Is it simply the weather, so wearily unpredictable?

Is it to overcome the awkwardness inherent in a half-denied class system? Is it just because the English are more culturally advanced, and have realized there is no cure for the human condition but nice-tasting painkillers? All these possibilities are explored in Peter Dench's witty, challenging, sometimes dazzling, sometimes affecting photo diary of Anglo-Celtic drunkenness.

The result is a unique and compelling visual history, full of photography that bears a striking resemblance to the drinking it depicts: at best it is perfectly intoxicating".



TRAVEL

BY CAR

From the West, get onto the M62 and keep on going until it turns into the A63. That'll take you along the north shore of the Humber to Princes Quay.

From the south you can take the A1 and turn off at Newark-on-Trent (or Doncaster if you fancy) then head north east. Taking the A15 east of Scunthorpe will then bring you over the Humber Bridge and into Hull from the south. The Humber Bridge is a toll road, but travelling across it will be worth the views along, be sure to find out current toll charges.

From the North you can head down the A1 before joining the the M62 eastbound after Leeds or turn off at York to travel into Hull via beautiful Beverley.

From the East you may need a boat. Make sure you check your route on the AA's route planner beforehand.

BY TRAIN

Hull Paragon Interchange is the main railway station in Hull, which sits in the very heart of the city. Hull has its own rail link to the capital.

First Hull Trains run several services a day, seven days a week from London Kings Cross to Hull; have a look at their website to see timetables, live departures and buy tickets. Virgin Trains East Coast run regular services too, connecting Hull to the capital via Grantham and Newark North Gate. If you're heading to Hull from the west you can hop on the First Transpennine Express line from Manchester, which stops off in Huddersfield, Leeds and many other places too. Northern Rail also run a number of other local services, connecting Hull to Bridlington and Scarborough on the coast as well as York and Selby.

A busy taxi rank operates outside the station, and the bus station is under the same roof at Hull Paragon Interchange.

TRAVEL

BY COACH

You can catch the coach to and from Hull, with services running all over the country to Paragon Interchange.

National Express will have you in Hull from London in under 6 hours by coach. Megabus also run a service where you can catch the train from Kings Cross St. Pancras to East Midlands Parkway, and then a bus over to Hull.

BY AIR

Flights from across Europe and the UK land at Humberside Airport every day.

Car hire is available at the airport, and the city centre is about a 30 minute drive away over the Humber Bridge. Stagecoach also operate the Humber Flyer bus service, which takes you directly into Hull from the airport.

BY SEA

Possibly our favourite way to travel into Hull, P&O operate ferry links between Hull and Northern Europe.

Daily overnight trips sail from Rotterdam in the Netherlands as well as Zeebrugge in Belgium to Hull Ferry Terminal, taking passengers with cars as well as those on foot.

Taxis from the ferry terminal into the city centre cost about £10, and a regular bus runs into the city from the Northern Gateway roundabout (about a 20 minute walk away from the ferry) costing around £2.50.


